



Student Safety Guidelines for COVID 19

Entering/Exiting Buildings – We ask that you use the following doors for entering and exiting buildings.

- Science & Technology Center – entrance north door between Student Center – exit the main doors either the south or west door
- Student Center – entrance south door between Science & Technology Center – exit – Library door
- Family Support Center – main entrance - exit west door at end of classroom hallway
- Entrepreneurial Center – main entrance – exit west door at end of classroom hallway
- Trades – East door by classrooms – same door for exit
- Mobridge site – main entrance - same door for exit
- McLaughlin site – main entrance – exit emergency door by GED

Masks – Masks are required to be worn at all times. There will be masks located at every entrance for your convenience.

Health Check on SBC App- If you do not have the SBC app, it can be downloaded for free from your cell phone app store.

Once you have it downloaded, you must check into the app using your SBC email address. If you do not have access to a cell phone, contact Lindsay Sandquist, Outreach Coordinator at 701.854.8019. Once you have the app and are logged in, you will receive a push notification each day to complete a health check. If you answer no to all the screening questions, you will receive a cleared health check. **You only have to check in on days that you will be on campus.**

QR Codes – Contact tracing will be completed through the use of QR Codes in which you use the SBC app to scan when entering a building and a classroom. Steps for scanning the codes are listed below:

- On the top left of the home screen of the SBC app, there is a box with a line through the middle, click that icon.
- It will then open your camera, and prompt you to scan the QR code.
- Once you scan the QR code, it will say you have successfully checked in. Please make sure you are checking into each building and each classrooms you enter

Please check into every building and every classroom that you enter each day you are on campus.

Temperature kiosk - there will be a kiosk at the entrance of each building. You just walk up to it and on the right side is a sensor, that you hold your wrist about an inch way to detect your temperature. If your temperature is below 100.4, you will get a cleared to enter. If above the acceptable rate, you will get a warning not to enter. Security will then be notified and they will come and do a manual temperature check. **The temperature check needs to be completed each time you enter a building.** If you want you can do throughout the day if you are concerned about your temperature.

Classrooms protection – Each classroom has been equipped with a hyper allergenic air machine. It is a small device that is plugged into the wall. It covers 2500 square feet and has been tested to kill HINI and COVID viruses. All classrooms are equipped with wipes and hand sanitizer at each door. We are asking that you assist with wiping off tables and chairs at the end your class. If they want you can do before also. In addition, we have janitorial staff focusing on bathrooms, and higher traffic areas throughout the day.

Spaces – all spaces have been setup for social distancing. So please do not move tables and chairs around. Classrooms need to stay in their current layout.

Study spaces – Study spaces have been setup for students that have a break in classes at the Student Center. Students can use the computer lab in that building, library, the student lounge, and the classroom across from the student lounge. In addition, students can study at the STC atrium area. At the Mobridge and McLaughlin sites, students can study in the lounge areas and can use the computer lab as long as there are no classes.
