The NACTEP grant is a funding source to assist students enrolled in one of the following degrees at SBC: Criminal Justice, Lay Advocacy-Paralegal, Practical Nursing, Heavy Equipment, Information Technology, Electrical Certificate, Commercial Driving License. The grant may pay for stipends, books, daycare expenses, or transportation.

- I am an individual with other barriers to educational achievement, i.e. limited English proficiency.
- I am currently in; **OR** have aged out of the foster care system.
- I have a parent who:
 - Is a member of the armed forces (as such term is defined in section 101(a)(4) of title 10, United States Code 10. **OR**
 - Is on active duty (as the term is defined in section 101(d)(1) of the title).
