It's a classroom setting felt amazing to be among others who are eager to learn.

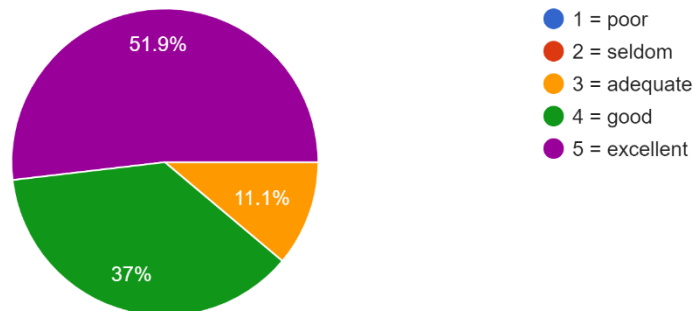
