| Data Analysis | The Governance Committee completed due diligent in reviewing policies and procedures that were presented to the committee. |
| Action/Recommendation | Continue to approve policies changes as they arise. |

| Findings/Results | Twelve new grants were submitted for a total of \$1,547,840 of possible funding. Five grants were funded at 33%, five not funded, and three pending as of May 31, 2019. The five grants funded as of June 30, 2019 total of \$728,691. |
| Data Analysis | SBC did not meet the measurement goal for the number submitted or funded. There are not as many grants that were due during the 18-19 term as there are in other years. |
| Action/Recommendation | Continue to encourage faculty and staff to write grants. |
