



- 5 Through the nursing program I was taught very important critical thinking skills that I need to have as a nurse. I also learned technical skills that helped with with computers. These skills I use everyday in life and I also need them for clinicals.
- 6 This was revealed to me by making it to class to learn what to think when setting career goals and how to accomplish them and that is to make them a priority.
- 7 Gaining these skills through all of my courses I've taken through the two years I've been at SBC have significantly helped me throughout my education and will further help with as I continue my education at a university. I wasn't confident with my math skills, after taking classes here at SBC really boosted up my confidence and made everything about the subject a lot clear!
- 8 This outcome was revealed to me at Sitting Bull College by my nursing instructors every day. Critical thinking is a very important trait to have as a nurse and our instructors stressed it and worked with us on it every day. Examples include every day we worked at the hospital, using our critical thinking skills when caring for our patient.
